KICKING OFF PHASE 2.



I cannot express to you how excited I am to be writing this letter. It marks the kick-off of what I have called “Phase 2” in the *Remember Ambassadors* program. Phase 1 is the online presence at www.RememberAmbassadors.com, designed to keep you up-to-date on the needs of the persecuted church and equip you with resources to help them.

Phase 2 is action. Now, you and I know that the entire Body of Christ is responsible to minister to the needs of our persecuted brothers and sisters. We should all be praying for their needs, and ministering to the widow and orphan in our midst. But you are receiving this letter because you have indicated your desire to do something more than that. Because of your passion for the persecuted church, you are the key to *Remember’s* ministry.

THE NEED IS NOW.

One of the key components of *Remember’s* outreach is our annual fundraising banquet. Last year—our first banquet—was full of the blessing of God. 600 people heard the message of Christ’s hope in the face of suffering, and were given a chance to reach out and help our persecuted brothers and sisters. Many responded—by giving generously, by getting involved, and by pledging to pray faithfully for the needs that they were made aware of.

Based on that success, we are currently planning our next banquet, to be held October 2, 2008, at the Charleston Convention Center in North Charleston. We are praying for 800-1,000 attendees that night! As you can imagine, an event like this takes a significant amount of money—and that is where I would ask you to be

Would you make it your personal goal to raise \$500 or more for the banquet? Think about that for a minute—it could represent 20 of your friends giving \$25 apiece. We each have our circles of influence that we can use to bless the widows and orphans of martyrs, and there is no better opportunity than this banquet.

And will you pledge to start praying, right now, for October's banquet? Many things go into the planning and preparation for such an event, and we need God's blessing from the very beginning. With that blessing, though, there is no limit to the blessing we can pour out on the persecuted church.

WHY DOES YOUR WORK MATTER?

Remember has made a pledge to donors that 100% of money received, if not specifically designated otherwise, goes directly to the needs of the persecuted church, and we take that pledge seriously. For that reason, no “normal” donations go towards things like banquet expenses. The only money that we will put towards the banquet is money that has been specially designated for that purpose.

But the potential reward is amazing. Only God knows how much funding, how much prayer support, and how much active involvement a banquet of this magnitude can reap for the needs of the widows and orphans of martyrs. Your work to raise funds for the banquet is like a seed planted, and the results will grow to bless lives for years to come.

When we all work together, we have the potential to do amazing things. Will you join this vital effort?
